1. Stay on the marked carriage trails.
2. Horses are not permitted in the Visitor's Center Courtyard.
3. Ride at a walk, trot or canter – Galloping is prohibited.
4. Brother's Path (the trail around Swan Lake) is a walk-only area.
5. Horses must be properly saddled and bridled; Riding double or bareback is prohibited.
6. EACH horse must have a rider who is in control of only one horse at a time:
No "Ponying". Carriage drivers are the only exception to this rule.
7. Meet and pass other horses, walkers and vehicles at a walk and in single file.
8. Be aware that people in wheelchairs may not be as maneuverable as those on foot.
9. Riders age 14 years and younger are required by law to wear an ASTM certified riding helmet.
10. Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
11. If you choose to bring a dog with you, it must be on a leash.

Please be sure your permit is VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES while in the Preserve.

Permits can be attached to the horse's tack or rider's attire.

PERMITS ARE NOT TRANSFERRABLE.

Permits are issued to the Rider or Driver (not the horse). This person's name appears on the permit tag.

**VIOLATION OF THE RULES WILL RESULT IN PERMIT REVOCATION.
A REVOKED PERMIT MEAN YOU ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED TO RIDE IN THE PRESERVE.**

NOTICE : Equestrian Safety at Swan Lake (Brothers' Path)

As you may know, the RSPP is a multi-use resource that plays host to a variety of patrons, including occasional groups of "special-needs" patrons. Visits by these "special needs" groups are most common on Tuesday and Friday mornings, from 10:00 am to 11:30 am and are primarily limited to the Swan Lake and Brothers' Path. Occasionally, some group members may make loud noises or sudden unexpected gestures that may potentially frighten horses. It is highly recommended that equestrians (a) avoid these groups or the Swan Lake trails if at all possible or (b) exercise maximum caution when traversing this area during the above stated times.

Our primary goal is to insure the safety of all RSPP visitors. Your cooperation regarding this matter is greatly appreciated.
